GSDSEF Project Screening Information, 2009

Invitations to apply for admission to the 2009 Greater San Diego Science and Engineering Fair (GSDSEF) will be issued **ONLY** at the Fair's eight screening fairs. Each school (public, private, parochial, home, etc.) in San Diego and Imperial Counties will be scheduled for one of these fairs and assigned the number of projects to be submitted for screening.

In preparation for screening, teachers must make sure the forms required for each project are completed, signed and in the students notebooks.

Registration at GSDSEF screening fairs is typically scheduled between 2:30 and 5:30pm the day prior to the fair.

Projects must be picked up at the screening fair site between 3:00 and 5:00pm the day of the screening fair. Projects left after 5:00pm will be locked up on site. Teachers or their pre-assigned representatives may pick up the list of projects invited to the GSDSEF and the comments from the screeners for each project between 3:00 and 5:00pm.

Teachers are responsible for telling students if they have been invited to apply to the GSDSEF.

NOTE: Do not show or give the screeners' comments to students. Instead, paraphrase and share the information with them.

GSDSEF Entrance Application and Procedures, 2009

Students invited to apply to the GSDSEF must follow these steps in submitting the **2009 Application for Entrance** and confirming their participation in the GSDSEF:

- Download and print the **2009 Application for Entrance** available on the GSDSEF website, www.gsdsef.org.
- Submit the **2009 Application for Entrance**, including a check or money order for the non-refundable application fee and **(optional)** lunch fee (attach to application with a paperclip, not a staple) to:

The **DEADLINE** for the **2009 Application for Entrance** is **February 15, 2009** or **10 days** after the screening date **(whichever comes first)**.

You will be notified if the GSDSEF Scientific Review Committee (SRC) needs additional information or your project is deemed unsuitable for admittance to or display at the GSDSEF.

GSDSEF Terms of Entry, 2009

By registering your project at the GSDSEF you agree to the terms in the **GSDSEF Rules and Regulations** and guarantee that all information provided to the GSDSEF is correct to the best of your knowledge.

In addition, you accept and agree to the following:

- Projects will be registered and set up on Tuesday, March 31, 2009 between 1:30 and 7:00pm. Items which must be removed from the display **IMMEDIATELY** after judging will be specified during the Registration process and must be taken from the Balboa Park Activity Center (BPAC) by the exhibitor (signed off by a GSDSEF staff member) at the end of the last judging session on Wednesday, April 1, 2009.
- Exhibitors **MUST** be present for the entire judging day — 7:45am to approximately 3:00pm
- No food or food products may be brought into the BPAC or included in or on project displays
- Neither glitter nor ball bearings is allowed in the BPAC
- Liquids allowed in the BPAC **ONLY** if in **screw top** containers
- Projects may **ONLY** be removed from the GSDSEF between 3:00 and 5:00pm on Sunday, April 5, 2009.
